Note About Refunds:

- All payments are NON-REFUNDABLE. We send deposits directly to the tour provider (Bon Vivant Educational Tours), so funds are not kept in a school account. The price of the trip is directly related to the number of participants, so fluctuations in participants causes the price to change as well. If your student is no longer able to participate, we will do our best to fill their spot on the trip with another student, at which point we can return any payments. If we are unable to fill that spot, a refund will not be possible.

Other Notes

- Additional student meetings will take place closer to the trip date (room assignments, final itinerary, expectations)
